Our breakfast clubs are available at Brambles, Beanos, Badgers, Buddies, Chaffinch, Dazzlers, Minnows, Satellites, Willows & Snapdragons Playsafe clubs.

We provide a healthy breakfast that allows children to have preferences and caters for special dietary requirements. Children will be encouraged to have a portion of fresh fruit or yogurt as well as choosing from the cereals etc.

A selection of quiet activities will be available.

We expect all parents/carers to sign their child into breakfast club.

After School Club End of School Day - 6.30pm*

Our afterschool clubs are available at Badgers, Brambles, Beanos, Buddies, Bobcats, Chaffinch, Chestnuts, Daffodils, Dazzlers, Harriers, Keston playsafe, Minnows, Satellites, Stanleys, Snap dragons, The Study, Wagtails, & Willows Playsafe clubs.

At the end of school your child will be met by club staff either at their class or in a designated area of the school.

The club provides a light tea and this is served before 5pm, with the exception of children at other clubs within the school. **This isn't expected to be the last meal of the day.**

We have 2 options for the afterschool club an "Early" session to 5pm or a "Late" session to 6.30pm

Buddies, Satellites & Keston is open until 6.15pm. Snapdragons is open until 6pm.

Children from other primary schools can attend the holiday clubs but must be in Reception to Year 6.
