Transfer to Secondary School September 2021

You must complete the online application process for your child which must be received by your child's home Local Authority by midnight 31st October 2020

You can apply online from 1 September 2020 at: www.sutton.gov.uk/admissions

If you are unable to apply online you should obtain a Common Application Form from your home local authority and ensure it is submitted by the closing date of 31st October 2020

You must list all the schools that you wish to apply for on your application





Supplementary Forms and Online Registration

Carshalton Boys Sports College – No supplementary form or online registrations required

Carshalton High School for Girls - allocate up to 24 places according to aptitude in Music or Sport. If applying for one of these places you must complete the school's supplementary form online by midnight on 25th September 2020

Glenthorne High School - Glenthorne High School allocates up to 24 places according to aptitude in the performing arts. Only if you wish to apply for one of these places must you complete the Performing Arts online web form by midnight 25th September 2020

All applicants should complete an online registration form for the Glenthorne

Banding test by midnight 31st
October 2020

Harris Academy Sutton - No supplementary form or online registrations required

Oaks Park High School - No supplementary form or online registrations required

Overton Grange School – No supplementary form or online registrations required

Sutton Grammar School for Boys Wallington County Grammar School Wilson's

An online registration form must be completed and returned directly to these schools by **14th August 2020**

Greenshaw High School

Greenshaw allocates 60 places on the basis of ability. If you wish to apply for one of these places you must complete the online registration form by 14th August 2020

The above schools run a shared selective eligibility test. To register, go to any one of these schools' websites. You only need to register your child once.

St Philomena's The John Fisher School

St Philomena's and The John Fisher each have a supplementary form, which must be completed and returned directly to the school for all applicants. For both schools by 31st October 2020



Hints to Help You with Your Application

If you live in London or Surrey, you should apply only at www.sutton.gov.uk/admissions.

If you are unable to apply online, equest the Connect Application Form from the Local

Authority in which your child lives and return the completed orm to that Local Authority by 31 october 2020

If you do not apply online or complete the Common Application Form your child will not be considered for admission to any school

On the application you must list all the maintained schools that you wish to apply for (not independent schools), wherever they are located, in the order that you prefer them. You can apply for up to 6 schools. Put your most favoured school at the top, working down to your least favoured at the bottom.

If you fail to include a school that you wish to apply for on your application, your child will not be considered for that school.

Each school will consider your application according to its admissions criteria, without knowing where you have placed them on the form, or which other schools you have applied for. A summary of the admission criteria for Sutton schools will be contained in Sutton's online booklet (available during the summer holidays) or look at the schools' websites. If you are applying for schools outside of Sutton, please obtain a copy of the Local Authority booklet for details of the admission criteria, as criteria may be different for each school and borough.

If you are applying to one of these schools (see overleaf for Sutton schools), you must make sure that you complete and return the supplementary form/online registration by the date specified. If you are applying to schools outside of Sutton, you must find out if they require a supplementary form/online registration.

You are advised to apply for as many schools as possible. The more you apply for the greater the likelihood of being allocated a school place on 1 March 2021. If you apply for more schools after the allocation because your child has not been successful for the ones you initially asked for, there is no guarantee that vacancies will arise.
