To start with, we thought about how to make a jam sandwich. We learnt that the order in which to make them was important! After we made our sandwiches, we

went to the playground to have our picnic with our teddies. Once we all had our delicious food and drink, we talked about why our teddies are special. We discovered that Queen Elizabeth loved jam sandwiches too and had one every day since she was five years old. 1-minute Maths is a FREE app aimed at Key Stage 1 pupils and



focuses on adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing. You choose a topic and answer a series of randomly generated questions. When the one minute is up, the questions are automatically marked and shown on a breakdown screen, providing instant feedback

Who's it for?

This first version of the app is aimed at Key Stage 1 pupils, and focuses on adding and subtracting – and on 'Subitising'. We've also just added multiplication and division topics! The free mobile app is available for Apple/iOS, Android and Kindle.

How does it work?


1-minute maths offers children engaging and easily accessible practice in basic number. There's no specific route or starting point. Having chosen a topic, each user answers a series of randomly generated questions (a different set of questions every time means they learn the concept, not a sequence of answers).

When the one minute's up, the questions are automatically marked and presented on a breakdown screen, giving instant feedback on how they've done. If they're struggling with a question, a 'Hint' button reformats the question as a familiar manipulative display that mirrors the approaches used in the White Rose Maths schemes of learning. Great for home & school use!

Although we hope you'll enjoy using 1-minute maths in class, we believe that it's also a fantastic and accessible tool for children to use outside the school day, too.
