In addition, please continue to practise the Oxford Reading Tree '**First Words**'. These are at the front of your child's reading records. Please also remember to date and write a brief comment every day when you read at home.

Mathematics: We have been focusing on numeral formation, the names and properties of 2D shapes (circle, rectangle, square and triangle) and 3D shapes (cone, sphere, cube, cuboid, cylinder).

This week we are working on **1 more and 1 less** than a given number to 10.

There is still time for you to send in 'house' and 'holiday' photos. The children have enjoyed sharing these with their friends. 'Show and Tell' is only on Fridays. Please encourage your child to leave toys at home on other days.
