Mathematics:

This week we have been working on using positional language effectively to describe where things are. Please practise at home using language such as 'in front, behind, over, on top, under, between and next to'.

Literacy:

Please continue supporting your child with letter sounds as well as learning the high frequency words. Don't forget the key words for Stage 1 of the Oxford Reading Tree books are at the front of the reading record books.

This week's sounds are: ck, e, u, r -

Please continue to practise all the sounds that we have introduced to date using flashcards and continue to think of words that start with these sounds:

s/a/t/p/i/n/m/d/g/o/c/k

High frequency words: the, get, got, to, and

Thank you for all the positive feedback that we have had about the weekly phonics tasks and for using Evidence Me to record your child's learning. We are practising **blending** and **segmenting** simple words daily. To build on these skills at home you can play a version of the game 'I spy'. Place some objects in front of your child and slowly say the sounds that make up the word. For instance, v-a-n. They can then have their turn at segmenting the sounds for a different object.
