Dear Parents/Carers,

This week is 'Sun Safety Week'. We will be checking and recording the UV index each day and thinking about what we need to do to enjoy the sunny weather safely.

We will be looking at ladybirds and we will find out about other types of beetles too. We will explore where they live and look at life cycles. We will share stories such as *The Bad Tempered Ladybird* and *What the Ladybird Heard*, and use the 'five finger' structure to retell familiar stories and begin to plan and write our own stories.





Key vocabulary: first, next, after, finally

In RE this week, we will share the story of <u>Jesus and Zacchaeus</u> and consider how Jesus 'rescued' people who were lonely.

Phonics: We will focus on words ending in <u>-ing</u>, such as *zooming*, *singing*; *words ending* in <u>-ed</u>, such as *bumped*, *grunted* and words ending in <u>-est</u>, such as *softest*, *strongest*.
