




Dear Parents/Carers,

We are encouraging the children to think of dinosaur-related questions they would like to find answers to. If your child comes up with an interesting question at home, please share it with us on Evidence Me so that we can look for the answer in books or on the internet as a class.

Phonics: Here are our new digraphs (two letters, one sound) for this week:

oo (catchphrase: *zoom to the moon*),

oo (catchphrase: *hook a book*),

ar (catchphrase: *march in the dark*)

or (catchphrase: *born with a horn*)

Maths: We will be comparing and ordering bones and dinosaurs by length and weight, and exploring the life cycle of a dinosaur. We will use the language 'first' 'next' and 'then' when talking about the sequence of events.
