Our new topic is about minibeasts, 'Creep Wriggle Crawl!'

RE: This term we will explore the question, *How did Jesus 'rescue' people?* This week we will share the story of <u>The Feeding of the Five Thousand</u> and consider how Jesus 'rescued' people who needed food.

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Phonics: We begin Phase 4 this week and will focus on CVCC (consonant vowel consonant consonant) words with short vowels, such as *went*, *lamp*, *best*.

New tricky words: said, so, have, like

Please continue to help us by practising **reading and writing** Phase 2 and 3 tricky words at home and using them in sentences, which encourages fluency in reading and writing. Encourage your child to use the tripod grip when holding a pencil.

Handwriting: This week's letter is **h**, and the catchphrase is 'Down, up and over the helicopter.'



Maths: We will begin to 'build' numbers beyond ten. For example, talking about numbers such as 14 as '10 and 4 more'. We will practise matching and counting amounts to 20.
