
Dear Parents/Carers,



beginning with that sound. Please do not write on any other pages. Please return the book to school by the following Tuesday so that it can be prepared for the following week. This week's letter is a, and the catchphrase is 'Around the astronaut's helmet and down into space.'



Phonics: Here are our new <u>digraphs</u> (two letters, one sound) and <u>trigraph</u> (three letters, one sound) for this week:

ur (catchphrase: curl the fur),
ow (catchphrase: wow owl),
oi (catchphrase: boing boing)
ear (catchphrase: get near to hear)



Maths: We will be focusing on 3D shapes: **sphere, cone, cube, cuboid, cylinder** and using vocabulary such as *straight, curved, edge, point, face, flat, roll, slide, stack* to describe and sort them.

RE: As part of our whole school vision, we are continuing to focus on the Good Shepherd and the story of the Lost Sheep. The children enjoyed our lost sheep hunt in the EYFS outdoor area!
