Reading diary:

When reading at home, please write the date and a brief comment in the yellow reading diary. Reading diaries should be brought to school every day.

In school, we will be reading three times a week with an adult concentrating on decoding, prosody and comprehension skills. The Little Wandle books will be sent home on a Friday and must be returned back for the Monday.

Mathematics:

We have been learning to subitise numbers 1-3 (the ability to look at a small number of objects and instantly recognise how many objects there are without needing to count).

At home, you can share stories/songs and pictures which represent 1, 2 and 3 (eg - Goldilocks and the three Bears, counting songs/dice games) and point out the groups. You can also encourage your child to find objects whilst noticing 1, 2 and 3 in the environment.

Library:

On Monday, children can select a book from the library if they have returned their previous library book which can be kept for a week. This is a great resource so enjoy reading a new library book every week.
