Please revise all of the tricky words from Phases 2-4. (See Evidence Me post on 17<sup>th</sup> May.)

## Maths:

We will be focusing on saying the number that is 1 more or 1 less than a number up to 20, number bonds to 10 and counting forwards and backwards along a number line to work out addition and subtraction number stories.

**Handwriting:** As this is a four-day week at school, we will not introduce a new letter this week. We will introduce two new letters next week instead. Please work on the letter formation of any letters that your child needs more practice with on paper at home.

When working on handwriting at home, please ensure that your child uses a **lead** pencil (no felt tips/colouring pencils/biros please). Your child should be sitting comfortably and holding the pencil with the correct tripod grip.
