RATIONALE

At St Dunstan's, Cheam, C of E Primary we pride ourselves in looking smart with our school uniform. Wearing uniform promotes a sense of community within the school and allows children to demonstrate their pride in their school, both within school and when they are out in the local community.

Our uniform is a simple, practical one, most of which can be bought in local supermarkets/high street clothes retailers. Our school's PTFA also run termly good-as-new uniform sales.

Branded items are available, but for the most part are optional. **Only the school tie and the book bags are required to be branded.**

We expect children to be smart, well presented and to wear full school uniform at all times, including their journey to and from school and we ask for parents/carers support in helping to maintain the highest of standards.

Year 1 – Year 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Choice of: grey trousers/grey shorts/navy pinafore/navy skirt • Light blue shirt (long or short sleeved) and St Dunstan’s tie* • In the summer term, a sky-blue gingham dress may be worn • Navy blue V-neck sweater or cardigan, branded* or unbranded • Grey socks with trousers/shorts • White, navy socks or navy tights with pinafore/skirt/summer dress • Sensible black or navy shoes • Plain navy raincoat <i>(Optional branded* navy school waterproof fleeces are available whilst stocks last)</i> 	
Physical Education Year 1 - 6	Branded* or unbranded blue polo shirt and navy shorts Black plimsolls or black trainers. Navy tracksuit bottoms can be worn in cold weather. For swimming a one-piece costume or close-fitting swimming trunks (not loose swimming shorts) should be worn.	
Bookbags	All children are required to have a school book bag. Children in Nursery, Reception and up to Year 2 should have an Infant book bag. Children in Year 3 to Year 6 should have a Junior book bag which is available to buy online through Stitch Design.	
Hats	A navy branded* or unbranded winter hat	A navy branded* or unbranded summer cap

In winter plain navy tracksuit bottoms may be worn over uniform for the journey to and from school and at playtime. Trainers are suitable for changing into for playtimes, but not for wear in class.

ORDERING BRANDED SCHOOL UNIFORM ITEMS

*All branded items of school clothing that carry the school logo i.e. sweatshirts, cardigans, polo tops, junior book bags, as well as ties are available to purchase online through our uniform suppliers - Stitch Design www.stitchdesign.co.uk. The delivery charge is currently £3.30 per order for delivery to your home address. All other items of uniform can be purchased from most supermarkets or high street clothes retailers.

JEWELLERY, HAIR AND MAKE-UP

Children are not allowed to wear personal jewellery such as rings, bracelets to school. In pierced ears, a plain round stud may be worn but must be removed for physical activities such as PE and games (including dance, gymnastics and swimming). If studs cannot be removed from newly pierced ears, children will be asked to cover the sharp point of the stud with micro pore tape. We do allow children to wear watches but they remain the responsibility of the child at all times.

For safety reasons, long hair should be tied back at all times. Only blue or dark coloured hair bands should be worn. No extreme styles of haircuts or eyebrow shavings are allowed. Hair must be of a natural colour and not dyed.

Make-up and nail varnish are not allowed to be worn at school at any time.
