In winter plain navy tracksuit bottoms may be worn over uniform for the journey to and from school and at playtime. Trainers are suitable for changing into for playtimes, but not for wear in class.

#### BOOKBAGS

All children are required to have a school book bag. Children in Nursery, Reception and up to Year 2 should have an Infant book bag. Infant book bags are £5.00 and are available to buy from the school office (cash only). Children in Year 3 to Year 6 should have a Junior book bag which is available to buy online.

#### ART AND DESIGN TECHNOLOGY

An overall is supplied by the school for the infants. Juniors should provide their own if parents consider this necessary. An old adult shirt with the sleeves cut to length is perfectly suitable, if gathered at the wrist.

#### **ORDERING COMPULSORY SCHOOL UNIFORM ITEMS**

\*All items of school clothing that carry the school logo i.e. sweatshirts, cardigans, polo tops and blazers, as well as ties are available to purchase online through our uniform suppliers - Stitch Design <u>www.stitchdesign.co.uk</u>. The delivery charge is currently £3.30 per order for delivery to your home address. All other items of uniform can be purchased from most high street clothes retailers.

#### JEWELLERY, HAIR AND MAKE-UP

Children are not allowed to wear personal jewellery such as rings, earrings or bracelets to school. In pierced ears, a plain round stud may be worn but must be removed for physical activities such as PE and games (including dance, gymnastics and swimming). If studs cannot be removed from newly pierced ears, children will be asked to cover the sharp point of the stud with micro pore tape. We do allow children to wear watches but they remain the responsibility of the child at all times.

For safety reasons, long hair should be tied back at all times. Only blue or dark coloured hair bands should be worn. No extreme styles of haircuts or eyebrow shavings are allowed. Hair must be of a natural colour and not dyed.

Make-up and nail varnish are not allowed to be worn at school at any time.
